

CSQ Short Course Eligibility Requirements

Eligible participants under this program:

(a) **must be:**

1. an Existing Worker in the Building and Construction Industry (see definition provided in Appendix 1); and
2. an Eligible Worker (see definition provided in Appendix 1); or
3. an Unemployed Eligible Worker (see definition provided in Appendix 1); and

(b) **must be:**

1. an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or
2. a permanent resident of Australia; or
3. a holder of a refugee or humanitarian visa; and

(c) **must:**

1. permanently reside in Queensland; or
2. be permanently employed in Queensland; and

(d) **must not be:**

1. currently enrolled and participating in a school program (excluding eligible school-based apprentices and trainees); or
2. a contracted trainer and assessor or an existing worker of any RTO; or
3. already funded by an Authority or other such source for delivery of the same training being undertaken as part of this program; or
4. previously funded under this program for three (3) short courses in the same program contract period.

Participants are eligible for a maximum of three (3) short courses in the same program funding period.

Appendix 1. Definitions

Existing Worker means a current Employee in the Building and Construction Industry who has a one-month or more employment relationship with their Employer. The working relationship can be built up through full-time, part-time or casual employment or engagement as a contract worker.

Eligible Worker has the same meaning as the *Building and Construction Industry (Portable Long Services Leave) Act 1991* (Qld) as amended from time to time.

Unemployed Eligible Worker means a person who has been unemployed for a period of not greater than 6 months that would otherwise meet the requirements of an Eligible Worker.
